Starting July 13: mandatory face coverings

- Free distribution July 13-26 and back-to-school
- Message displayed at front of buses
- > Audio message on buses and métro platforms
- Signage at station entrances and on all buses

Starting August 1 for students with **OPUS** cards

- > Online renewal on the portals of 100 establishments
- > Renewal by mail
- > Reservation system for the photo studio

Starting in mid-August

Information about the space available on buses provided on our website and partners' apps. Later this fall, information regarding trains on the Orange line

DURING TRIPS

BUSES

In progress:

Transformation of buses with the installation of protective screens and the creation of a separate driver area

Starting July 20

- > Gradual return to front-door boarding and fare validation
- > Mandatory exiting at the back to avoid having customers interact (with the exception of customers with functional limitations)
- > Relocation of reserved seats
- Communication inside buses to inform customers about new rules.

PARATRANSIT

In progress:

Back to fare collection since June 29 and two customers per vehicle starting in late July









Installation of over 200 hand sanitizer dispensers in all métro stations



- > General measures
- > Mandatory face coverings
- > Real-time information (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, website) on changes in our networks

MÉTRO

In progress:

Distancing stickers where customers are likely to line up (e.g., elevators, vending machines, booths)

Week of July 13:

- Reopening of Espaces clients, and resumption of after-sales service (card transactions only)
- Cash accepted by fare vending machines
- > Prototype for new signage designed to ensure smooth traffic flow. Based on the results, a rollout is planned in the network's priority stations

MÉTRO (suite)

August:

Start of rollout of contactless debit/credit card payment at fare booths in seven stations
