




Fare schedule

Effective July 1, 2022

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times across the metropolitan area while accompanied by a person aged 14 and over who is supervising them and holds a valid and validated transit fare. This person may not accompany more than five children.

1) The 1-trip magnetic fare cards for Zone A must be validated on STM equipment in order to be used for transfers in Zone A on trains and the REM, when it becomes operational.

2) Exact change is required for cash payment on buses.

3) You must have a photo ID OPUS card to pay the reduced fare. Riders 6 to 11 years of age have the option of buying a 1-trip fare card at the métro fare booth or paying cash on the bus without presenting a photo ID OPUS card. Riders 65 and up can pay the reduced fare with cash on the bus by presenting their photo ID OPUS card. Riders 12 to 17 years of age must load the reduced fare on their photo ID OPUS card.

4) The standard OPUS card without photo costs \$6 and must be loaded with a transit fare. The photo ID OPUS card costs \$6 for riders 6 to 11 years of age and \$15 for riders 12 to 17 years of age, students 18 years of age and up and riders 65 years of age and up.

5) Payment is made at designated Agence de mobilité durable parking pay stations. Valid only for travel to Montréal-Trudeau airport.

6) This fare on a magnetic fare card is available to a group travelling at the same time. It is only valid on the STM network, including the Laval and Longueuil stations.

7) This fare is valid for all bus services within and between zones A, B and C, except for exo bus lines to downtown Montréal. The list of these bus lines is available at <https://www.artm.quebec/en/fares/bus/>

▲ To load this fare onto an OPUS card, you must obtain a new card designated for this zone. More information is available at métro station fare booths and metropolitan ticket offices. Subject to applicable fees.

The possession and use of transit fares are subject to the Autorité régionale de transport métropolitain (ARTM) by-law prescribing conditions regarding the possession and use of transit fares for public transit services in the metropolitan area (CQLR, c. A-33.3, r.3).

In the event of a discrepancy, the fare schedule for public transit services adopted by the ARTM resolution takes precedence.
